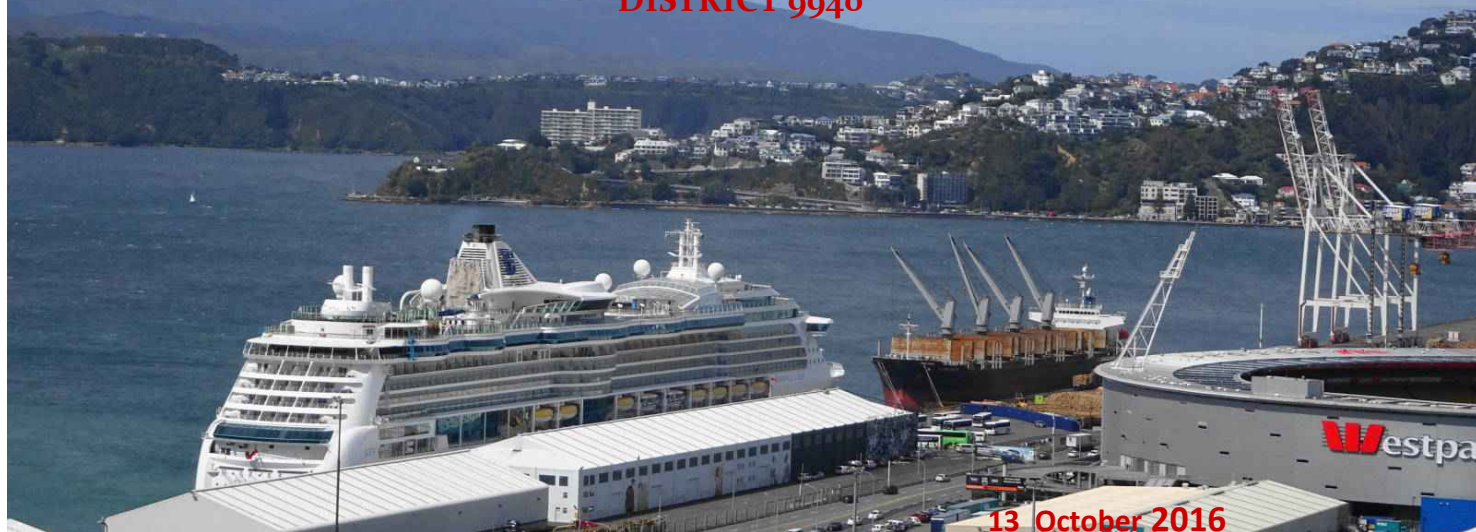

TODAY'S SPEAKER

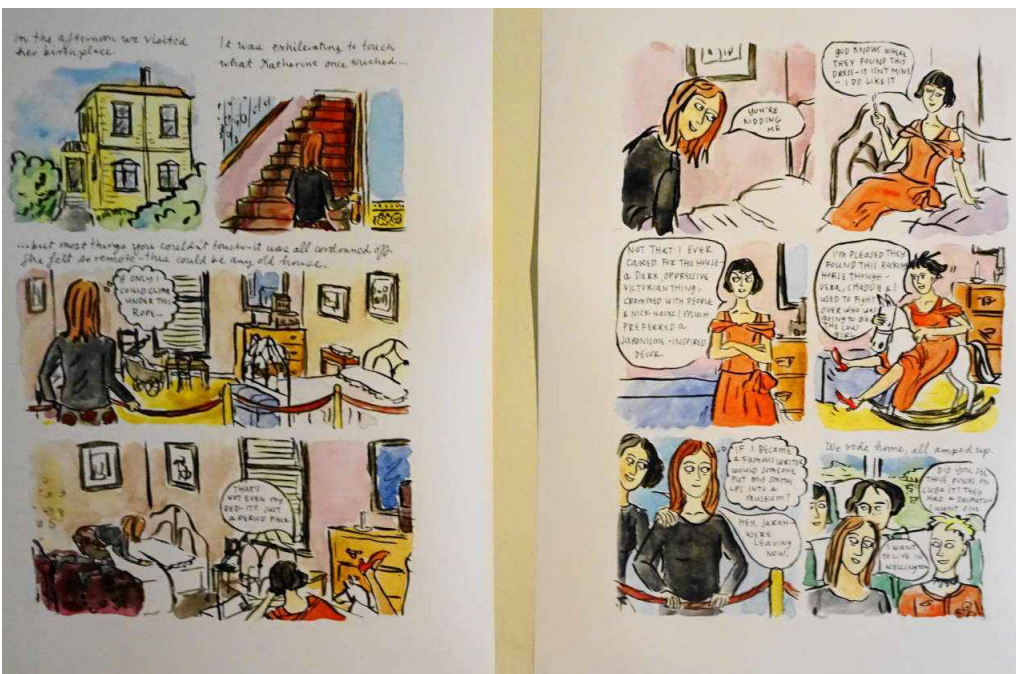
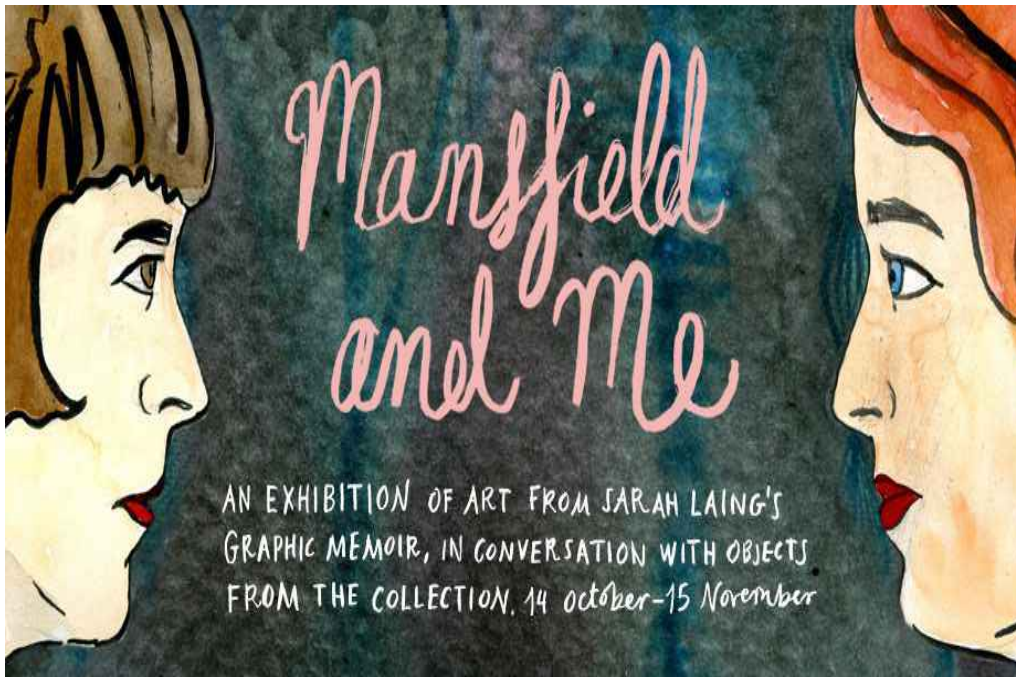
Michael Gorman introduced our member Emma Anderson who is the Director of Katherine Mansfield House and Garden.
