TODAY'S SPEAKER

John Mohi introduced our own David Bennett just returned from Uganda where he has been working to cope with the influx of refugees from the north. As the Salvation Army's disaster relief person David has worked overseas in a number of countries in recent years including Samoa, Nepal and now Uganda as well as working in Christchurch and Kaikoura.

David told us that Uganda is slightly smaller in area than NZ and has a population of forty-two million. It has one million three hundred thousand refugees. David showed us photos of camps not far from the northern border. And also photos of local villages. The standard of living in Uganda is not high. The photos showed that the shelter and services being provided for refugees were of a similar standard to that which the local population lived in.

David was concerned with the provision of latrines and water bores for clean water. Both are essential if safe hygiene standards are to be met. A donation of \$500,000 can provide 18 boreholes and latrines for 50 families.

Adrian Ellingham moved a vote of thanks.

The meeting closed with a blessing from Lionel Nunns.
